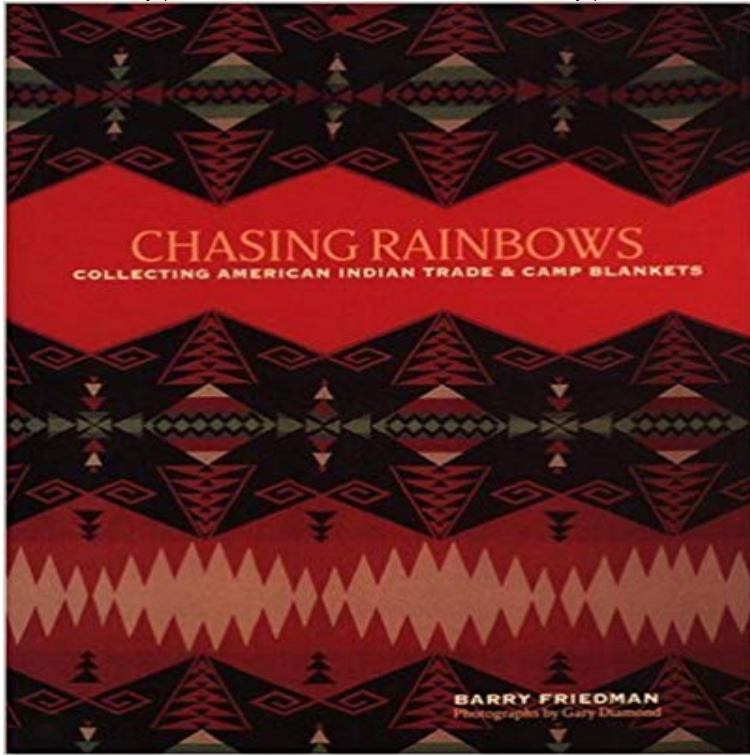


# Chasing Rainbows: Collecting American Indian Trade & Camp Blankets
